The Magic Of 8-Ball

#### Ladies Team - 8 Ball

- 4 Player Teams
- Race To 9 Double Knockout
- Teams may be comprised of any 4 players from within their League Operators League as long as they meet the 8 league night requirement.
- Entry Fee \$200

#### **OPEN Novice Team - 8 Ball**

- 4 Player Teams
- Race To 9 Double Knockout
- The team must be comprised of 3 original players and all 3 players must play in all rounds. The 4th player may come from any team in the league system as long as they meet the skill level criteria.
- Entry Fee \$160

#### **OPEN Intermediate Team - 8 Ball**

- 5 Player Teams
- · Race To 11 Double Knockout
- For the average player. Players that have won Vegas Trips in Rec or Fun divisions can compete in this division. The team must be comprised of 3 original players and all 3 players must play in all rounds. The 4th and 5th player may come from any team in the league system as long as they meet the skill level criteria.
- Entry Fee \$200

#### **OPEN Advanced Team - 8 Ball**

- 5 Player Teams (1 Canadian Master Player Allowed Per Team)
- Race To 13 Double Knockout
- For the above average player. Players that have won Vegas Trips in competitive leagues can compete in this division. The team must be comprised of 3 original players and all 3 players must play in all rounds. The 4th and 5th player may come from any team in the league system as long as they meet the skill level criteria.
- Entry Fee \$250

#### Men's Masters Team - 8 Ball

- 5 Player Teams
- Race To 13- Double Knockout or round robin based on entries
- A Master's Team may be comprised of any 5 players from within the League Operators league system as long as they meet the 8 league night requirement. All players ranked Master or Grand Master by the BCA, Master or Vegas Intermediate by the VNEA or Canadian Master by the WCVNEA (exception above) must play at this level.

#### **Tournament Eligibility**

- All Players must have played in a minimum 4 regularly scheduled league matches during a BCA sanctioned 2009/10 season.
- The above applies to Team, Singles and Scotch Doubles Events.
- All players **MUST** appear on a official BCA sanction list in order to compete in this event.
- All players must meet amateur status requirements. Men or Women deemed Professional players by the BCA or VNEA are prohibited from entering the tournament.
- All men appearing on the BCA Master or Grand

- Master and the VNEA Master or Vegas Intermediate list must compete in the Masters division
- Each team must be comprised of 3 original members (exception: Men's Masters & Ladies)
- Players of "known" ability should compete in the suitable events. Tournament organizers reserve the right to place players or teams in the event that they feel is appropriate.
- Rankings for Players and Teams from Western Canadian VNEA Championships will have their rankings recognized for the purposes of this event.

#### **Tournament Rules**

- Rules governing play are detailed in the latest edition of Billiards: The Official Rules and Records Book, published annually by the Billiard Congress Of America.
- Check in for the Singles and Team Events is **NOT** required as long as you appear on the draw sheets.
- No player may play for more than 1 Team and in 1 Singles event. Players may be listed on more than 1 Team roster but once they play in a match with that team they must play with that team for the duration of the tournament.
- Age Requirement: All entrants must have reached 18 years of age as of November 1, 2009.
- Team rosters, including players and substitutes, are set once the team event begins it first match.
   There will be a time when team's can make changes to their roster.
- All additions to a teams roster may come from any player within the League Operator's system.
   Four alternates may be added to the roster for a total of 7 players. All players and alternates must have played in 4 weeks of league play.

#### **Miscellaneous**

#### **Dress Code**

Dress code requirements are established to add to the prestige and respect associated with the event. Your cooperation in wearing neat, clean apparel at all times during competition for the betterment of the sport is appreciated.

#### **Second Chance Tournaments**

- This allows teams that are eliminated early from the tournament to compete in another event.
- Teams pay **NO ADDITIONAL** entry fee and share in the over-

all prize purse.

The cut-off points are marked on the draw sheets.

#### **Equipment**

- 40 7-foot Diamond coin operated pool tables.
- Cues less than 40" in length are illegal.
- · Chalk and bridges are provided.
- NO break cues will be provided.
- Coin boxes are closed during the tournament play and practice.
- Tables set on \$1.50. Change will be available in the tourna-

ment room.

#### **Entry Forms**

- All League Operators have been sent team and single entry forms.
- All entry forms must be filled out completely and legibly. Entry forms not filled out properly will be returned.
- The League Operated MUST submit all Single and Team entries and stats.
- League Operators or captain's should make any on-site roster changes needed, during the designated times.
