**Eligibility**: Players must have 8 weeks of BCAPL league play between June 1, 2015 and May 31, 2016 or be a CSI Member.

Format: double elim. / alt. break / rack your own / hdcp. using Fargo Ratings

**Mixed Singles (9-ball):** Begins Wed., June 8 @ 9am / \$500 added based on 64 players / Open to men & women / Cannot also play in scotch doubles

**Mixed Gold Singles (8-ball):** Top 50% of field (based on Fargo Ratings) Begins Thur., June 9 @ 9am or later / \$750 added based on min. of 64 players / Open to men & women

**Mixed Silver Singles (8-ball):** Bottom 50% of field (based on Fargo Ratings) Begins Thur., June 9 @ 9am or later / \$750 added based on min. of 64 players / Open to men & women

#### Women's Singles (8-ball):

Begins Thur., June 9 @ 9am or later / \$750 added based on min. of 64 players

#### **TEAMS:**

**Eligibility:** Players must have 8 weeks of BCAPL play between June 1, 2015 and May 31, 2016. All team members must come from the same league. A player may only be listed on one team roster.

Format: Double elimination / Handicapped using Fargo Ratings

## Mixed Gold Teams Division (5-Player)

Begins Sat., June 11 @ 9am or later / \$2,000 added based on min. of 32 teams **Team Rating Limit:** No team rated over **3,000** may register.

# Mixed Silver Teams Division (5-Player)

Begins Sat., June 11 @ 9am or later /\$2,000 added based on min. of 32 teams **Team Rating Limit:** No team rated over **2,750** may register.

## Women's Teams Division (4-Player)

Begins Sat., June 11 @ 9am or later / \$2,000 added based on min. of 32 teams **Team Rating Limit:** No team rated over **2,000** may register.

## MISC. INFO

Start Times: Every attempt will be made to begin each division at the posted start time. However, various factors could cause the actual start time to be delayed. Players should check the tournament brackets for exact start times.

Reading the Race Charts: In each match, the higher rated player or team races to the number indicated on the left. The lower rated player or team race can be found by using the "Find a Fair Match" section of the FargoRate application which can be found by clicking here. For doubles and teams, enter the average rating of the core roster (total combined rating / # of players). Note: races will be generated automatically on-site.

Example: The core roster of "Team A" has a combined rating of 2,889 while the core roster of "Team B" has a combined rating of 2,673. This means the average rating of "Team A" is 578 (2,889/5) and "Team B" is 535 (2,673/5). Using the FargoRate app, find the set of fair races between ratings of 578 and 535. "Team A" is the higher rated team and will race to 13 based on the chart above. Therefore, the race in this situation is 13-10.

**Doubles & Team Rating Changes:** There is a 10-point per player "cushion" if the team is eligible when they register but one or more members' ratings move up before the tournament to push them over the team limit. If the team's rating moves beyond the cushion, they will have the following options:

- Play and accept a 1-game penalty for every 40 points over the cushion
- Replace one or more players to get within the team rating limit

**Substitutions:** The core roster will be used to determine the team rating. A substitute may play in any round but the sub must be rated the same or lower as the core player being replaced. The team rating remains the same throughout the event as determined by the core roster.
