Refund Policy

Refund & change requests must be received in writing by email, fax, or postal mail by Feb 21, 2020 and will be processed after March 30, 2020. Admin fees are non-refundable and an additional \$20 processing fee applies to each entry refunded.

On-Site Registration

On-site registration must be cash only in US currency and received no later than 7pm on Tuesday, March 10. On-site registrations are non-refundable.

Dress Code

The following dress code will be strictly enforced. CSI has sole and final authority on all rules & regulations, including the dress code.

Approved Clothing

- Dress pants or casual slacks.
- Polo or button-down style shirt with sleeves, fold over or vertical collar. Button-down shirts may be worn unbuttoned if they are worn with a neat and tasteful undergarment. Button-down shirts worn without an undergarment may only be unbuttoned one button below the neck button or as deemed appropriate by the Tournament Director. Shirts should not be excessively loose or revealing.
- All footwear must be close toed and be normal in its style and wear. Shoes with laces must have the laces properly tied. Dark color tennis or walking shoes are acceptable but must be clean and neat.

Prohibited Clothing

- Athletic wear of any kind, including but not limited to sweats, swimwear, jogging suits, uniforms, jerseys or any type of pants with contrasting stripes not associated with formal wear.
- Shorts of any kind, regardless of apparent length. Pants must be normal in respect to the appropriate rise in relation to the length of garment and may not be excessively baggy or loose fitting.
- Overalls, coveralls, jeans, hats, headphones or ear pieces (unless medically needed written medical proof required)

Sponsor Logos and Patches

Players may wear a maximum of three (3) logos on playing apparel ("player's logos"). All logos, including apparel brand logos, are included in this maximum of three (3) restriction. Logos may not exceed six (6) square inches. The player must submit to CueSports International (CSI), before his or her first match, samples of all sponsor logos for approval. CSI reserves the authority to disallow any sponsor logos for any reason, including but not limited to not submitting logo for approval or conflicting with any other event or broadcast sponsor. Additionally, CSI reserves the right to require any player to display event sponsor logos on the player's apparel in addition to the three (3) logos allowed.

Start Times & Format

Divisions may begin as early as the times listed. However, various factors could delay start times and a delayed start is not grounds for a refund. Always check the tournament brackets at www.ctsondemand.com for the exact start time of your match.

Plan Your Travel Carefully

We encourage you to allow plenty of time before and after the event for travel. CueSports International is not responsible for airline delays, lost luggage, traffic jams or any other travel-related issue that could cause you to miss your match and be forfeited. Matches are not delayed or accelerated to accommodate travel issues. Therefore, you are advised to arrive early.

How to Avoid Forfeits

People sometimes forfeit matches because they do not follow the correct procedures. Matches are not announced at the event and there may be occasions when your table is not available at the scheduled time because earlier matches are running late. You are responsible to be at your assigned table when it becomes available. Please review Appendix A – Using CTS (CueSports Tournament System) and the Tournament Regulations. These documents detail the process of avoiding forfeits. If you still need help, please ask the Tournament Director. Being forfeited as a result of not following the correct procedures (see the Golden Rule below) is not grounds for a refund or a credit of any kind.

Golden Rule: If you are at your assigned table at the scheduled match time and do not leave, you cannot be forfeited.
